We are excited that more of our student-athletes are permitted the opportunity to participate in indoor athletic competitions. As a result, next week, indoor athletic competitions requiring tickets for spectators will commence. In accordance with the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) guidelines for youth sports, spectators for these events are limited to immediate household family members of a participating student-athlete only.

ALL permitted spectators must comply with the rules and guidelines set forth by the CDPH and the State. Failure to comply with these spectator guidelines may result in spectators not being permitted to attend future events.

All permitted spectators must secure a ticket, prior to the event, to attend. No tickets will be available at the gate or on the day of the athletic competition. These will be passed out to PHS athletes by their coaches. Visitors will use a guest list.

Ticket allotment for immediate household family members of a participating student: (The below ticket allotment is for home games only. We must comply with each school's rules pertaining to their unique limits on the number of immediate family members per athlete.)

## Day of Event:

- Arrive no earlier than 10 minutes prior to the game as event venues will be cleared of spectators between each game. Please stay in your car until 10 minutes before the start of the event. Masks are required while on campus.
- No outside food or beverages permitted, with the exception of water.
- If multiple contests are played on a single date, such as JV and Varsity contests, spectators will have to remain in the designated line, until the prior game has ended and everyone has cleared from the gym. If you wish to meet with your student immediately after the event, please make arrangements to meet them outside of the gym.
- No more than the ticket allotment per student-athlete will be allowed to enter the venue.
- Tickets allow for spectators for one game only, and all spectators must exit the venue immediately at the end of the event.
- Social distancing must be maintained -- Only immediate household members are to sit together in the stands. Immediate family groups must be six feet apart.
- All spectators, including children, must remain in the bleachers, with their immediate household group, except to use the restroom. No more than two people in the restroom at a time.
- MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES. If you are not wearing a mask, you will be asked to leave the venue.
- If anyone is experiencing or exhibiting any COVID symptoms prior to or at a PHS athletic event, please do not attend or please remove yourself from the event in order to protect others in the community.
- Any observers who choose not to abide by the above guidelines may be asked to modify their behavior, and /or leave the event, and may result in the stoppage of play until addressed properly.

\*The information above is subject to change. Please be patient as we work through this unprecedented situation.

\*\*We recognize that you can obtain more than the allotted number of tickets from those who choose not to use them. However, Ponderosa High School, in accordance with CDPH guidelines, will only allow the members of your immediate household to enter the game.
