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Parents of Seniors!

I bet you never thought your senior student would be starting their last year of high school like we have. Distance learning, virtual class learning and not being able to come to school. All being how it is, these seniors are taking each day in stride and we are all very proud of them.

This letter provides some important dates during the senior year and information regarding the graduation requirements. Please take the time to review your student's Aeries portal and their Transcript or Graduation Status in Aeries. We, Counselors have reviewed every seniors' credits and graduation status, and reached out as necessary to be sure your student is enrolled in what they need to complete their remaining credits. If you have concerns or questions, please contact your student's counselor (the counselor alpha breakdown is below).

To receive a high school diploma from the El Dorado Union High School District, students must complete all subject requirements and meet the 220-credit requirement. If your senior is planning to attend a four-year college right out of Ponderosa, we have included the minimum admission requirements to a California State University or University of California at the end of this letter.

Α	few things to keep in mind and monitor over the course of this school year:
	Your student must pass all classes needed to complete their remaining credits
	Must complete online class(es) or planned classes developed with your student's Counselor
	If your student is enrolled in a community college course and the credit from the course are needed to complete eir graduation requirements, your student must complete community college course with a passing grade.
	Pay attention to dates – all dates are imperative to know when applying to community college, financial aid, four- ar college and scholarships
