Scholarships

The process for applying is simple, but there are requirements and deadlines.

Complete the user profile www.CALocalScholarships.org and apply for the scholarships for which you are eligible. The scholarships that request specific applications usually have a Marc

link that you can click on to access it. If there isn't a link, come into the College & Career Center. Make certain to include all the requested documentation for each scholarship. Turn them in to the College & Career Center or mail them to the specific address listed on the website.

Folsom Lake College:

Once you complete an application, and have received a Los Rios Student ID number, you need to register to attend an Orientation Session https://flc.losrios.edu/admissions/orientation and then Create an Education Plan. Specific dates have been set aside for these meetings and you must sign up here https://flc.losrios.edu/student-resources/counseling/make-an-educational-plan.

You will need to bring a copy of your high school transcripts with you to this appointment.

Sierra College:

The Sierra College application for Fall 2020 is online and available now. Get online ASAP to apply, and complete your online orientation. You can call Sierra's Counseling Office to set up a counseling appointment. The Fall class schedule should be available in early March, and class registration begins in late April.

*** CA Community Colleges are no longer requiring you to take Assessment tests! You will receive your class placement in Math and English based on your transcripts and the classes & GPA you enter in your application when you apply.
