Scholarship Information

- * Local scholarships are being offered through the community website www.CALocalScholarships.org.
- Complete the <u>User Profile</u> on-line (this is the general or "CaLocal" application). Not every scholarship will use the User Profile as their application so pay attention to each scholarships specific requirements.
- Once the User Profile is complete, click on a scholarship title to see that scholarships requirements and due date. Click the PDF icon in the top left to print out the User Profile.
- Staple the User Profile together with the other documents that scholarship is requiring (most scholarships require a statement of your educational and career goals, a student resume as well as letters of recommendation).
- Some scholarships are due prior to March 2—watch the deadlines!

Federal Student Aid FAFSA

Seniors can submit the FAFSA beginning October 1, 2019 for the 2020-21 school year. The FAFSA enables students to start the financial aid process and tap into the many federal and state resources that make college affordable. These resources include student grants, work-study, and loans.

The FAFSA will use the 2018 tax return for the 2020-21 school year. Students need this tax information to answer many of the questions. At the same time, you'll learn the preliminary estimate of the amount your family is expected to contribute to your education. It is known as the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) and helps to determine any aid awards you might receive.
