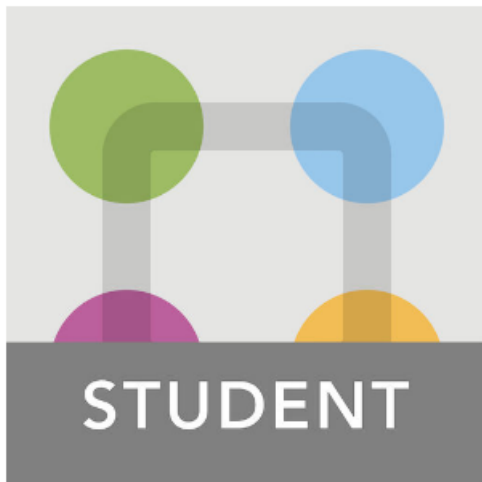

Requires: SAT or ACT w/ Writing

CSU Application:

Application opens: Oct. 1

Submission window: Oct.1-Nov.30

Application deadline: Nov. 30

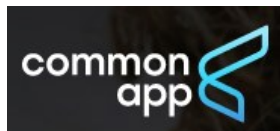
Requires: SAT or ACT (no writing)

The Common Application (for the 800+ member colleges) can be found at www.commonapp.org.

Deadlines can vary.



First Things First:

Sept.

- Begin the UC applications on-line however, these cannot be submitted until November 1.
- Register for SAT Reasoning, ACT and/or SAT Subject tests. Take these tests by the December test dates.
- Narrow down college choices by visiting campuses. Don't know which campuses offer your major—check out the website www.assist.org and click on "Majors" tab.
- Begin asking for letters of recommendation for private colleges & scholarships.
- Attend College Fair at Union Mine on Sep. 24 at 6:30 p.m.

Oct.

- Submit the CSU applications on-line at CalState.edu until November 30.
- Attend Financial Aid Night on Thu. October 10 at Oak Ridge High School
- Submit your FAFSA online using your parent/guardians 2018 taxes www.fafsa.ed.gov (attend the FAFSA Workshop on Nov. 13 for help with this)

Nov.

- Submit the UC applications until November 30.
- Submit the CSU applications until November 30.

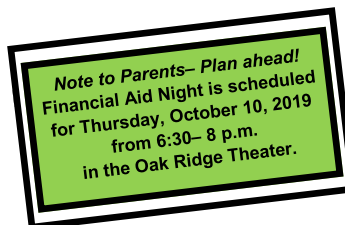
Updated Information: CalGrant GPA

Seniors, the **CalGrant GPA Verification form** will be automatically submitted for you by our Registrar Ms. Driscoll in the Counseling Office. The GPA Verification is required to be eligible for state grants.

Also, seniors should file for federal financial aid by submitting the **FAFSA (FREE Application for Federal Student Aid)** beginning **October**

1, 2019. Family income may be reported using 2018 taxes. Students must file by the March 2 deadline and will receive their student aid report (SAR) on-line. The SAR will give students and parents an opportunity to correct any information or send information to additional colleges. The SAR will also give students their expected family contribu-

tion (EFC). The EFC is the amount that families are expected to pay before any federal or state aid programs would be made available.

- Selective Service Information: The law requires all **male** U.S. citizens and male immigrants residing in the U.S. to register within 30 days of their 18th birthday. Therefore, to be in full compliance with the law, a male turning 18 is required to register during the period of time beginning 30 days before, until 30 days after his 18th birthday...a 60-day window.
