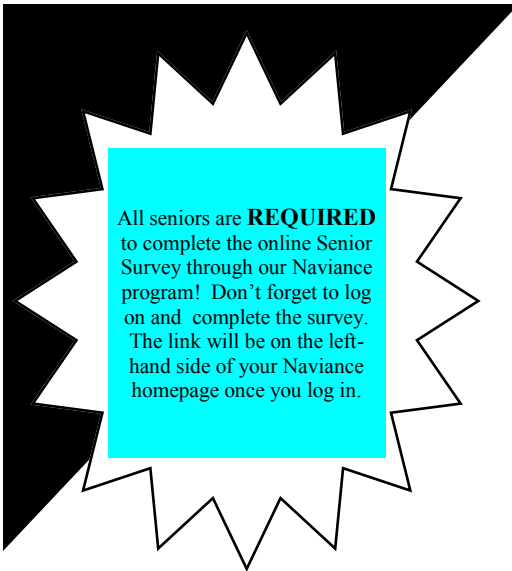

EPT/ELM

If you are attending a CSU this fall, double check to see if you are required to take the English Placement Test (EPT) or the Entry Level Math (ELM) exams. You may be exempt from taking the EPT if you scored over 500 on the SAT Critical reading, over 22 on the ACT or scored 3, 4, or 5 on the AP Lang/Comp or Lit/Comp exams. If you scored over 550 on the SAT Math, over 23 on the ACT Math or scored over a 3 on the AP Calc or AP Stat exams, you may be exempt from taking the ELM exam.

The EPT/ELM may be taken at Sac State and scores sent to your CSU campus. Check the following www.csus.edu/testing/tests/eptelm.html for more information.
