Thousands of dollars in scholarships are being offered by the local community to graduating seniors who plan to further their education at any vocational, technical, trade or business school, community college or 4-year university. The process for applying is simple, but there are requirements and deadlines. Complete the user profile at www.CALocalScholarships.org and apply for the scholarships for which you are eligible. The scholarships that request specific applications usually have a link that you can click on to access it. If there isn't a link, come into the Career

Center. Make certain to include all the requested documentation for each scholarship. Turn them in to the College & Career Center or mail them to the specific address listed on the website.

Community Colleges

Folsom Lake College:

Folsom Lake College has set aside Assessment testing dates for PHS students. **The reserved dates and the drop-in schedule dates are available in the PHS College & Career Center.** Testing is first-come, first served so arrive early and be sure to bring your Los Rios Student ID Number, a photo ID, and \$2 in quarters for parking.

Once you complete the Assessment Testing, you will need to meet with a counselor to Create an Education Plan. Specific dates have been set aside for new students to meet with counselors in a group format. You must sign up for the planning sessions through the FLC website at

You will need to bring a copy of your high school transcripts with you to this appointment.

Sierra College:

The Sierra College application for Fall 2017 is online and available now. Get online ASAP to apply, complete your online orientation, and then sign up for an assessment date. If you call Sierra's Counseling Office to sign up, you may be able to arrange to take your assessment and have your counseling appointment in the same day. The Fall class schedule should be available in early March, and class registration begins in late April.

All male students who are within 30 days of their 18th birthday are required to register with Selective Service. Registering with Selective Service does not mean that you are joining the military. Men in compliance with federal law and to be eligible for student loans and grants, government job training, all jobs requiring security background clearances, and U.S. citizenship for immigrants. Register online at www.sss.gov or stop by the College & Career Center for more information.
