



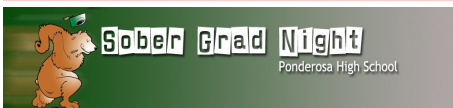
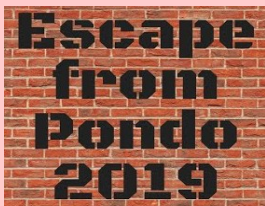

**Scholarships**

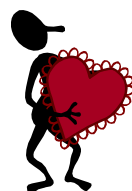
Thousands of dollars in scholarships are being offered by the local community to graduating seniors who plan to further their education at any vocational, technical, trade or business school, community college or 4-year university. The process for applying is simple, but there are requirements and deadlines.

Complete the user profile at [www.CALocalScholarships.org](http://www.CALocalScholarships.org) and apply for the scholarships for which you are eligible. The scholarships that request specific applications usually have a

link that you can click on to access it. If there isn't a link, come into the College & Career Center. Make certain to include all the requested documentation for each scholarship. Turn them in to the College & Career Center or mail them to the specific address listed on the website.

## Community Colleges

### Folsom Lake College:

Once you complete an application, have received a Los Rios Student ID number, and have completed Orientation, you will need to meet with a counselor to Create an Education Plan. Specific dates have been set aside for new students to meet with counselors in a group format. You must sign up for the planning sessions through the FLC website at the following link:

You will need to bring a copy of your high school transcripts with you to this appointment.

### Sierra College:

The Sierra College application for Fall 2019 is online and available now. Get online ASAP to apply, and complete your online orientation. You can call Sierra's Counseling Office to set up a counseling appointment. The Fall class schedule should be available in early March, and class registration begins in late April.

\*\*\* CA Community Colleges are no longer requiring you to take Assessment tests! You will receive your class placement in Math and English based on your transcripts and the classes & GPA you enter in your application when you apply. Stop by the CCC if you have any questions about this.

**All male students who are within 30 days of their 18th birthday are required to register with Selective Service. Registering with Selective Service does not mean that you are joining the military. Men must be registered to be in compliance with federal law and to be eligible for student loans and grants, government job training, all jobs requiring security background clearances, and U.S. citizenship for immigrants. Register online at [www.sss.gov](http://www.sss.gov) or stop by the College & Career Center for more information.**
