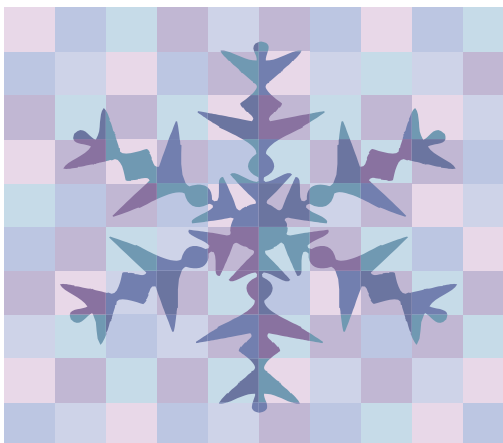

Scholarship Information

- * Local scholarships are being offered through the community website www.CALocalScholarships.org. Complete your user profile on-line and scholarships will be listed matching your profile with the scholarship criteria. Most scholarships require a statement of your educational and career goals, a student resume as well as letters of recommendation. Applications must be submitted by the March 1, 2018 deadline. **Some scholarships are due prior to March 1—watch the deadlines!**
- * Many scholarship applications are available in the College & Career Center or can be found online at the PHS website under College & Career Center and then College Information. Local organizations will be offering scholarships during the early spring months. Be sure to stop by and check the scholarship drawers frequently. Select scholarships that you meet the criteria for and complete the applications by the due date.

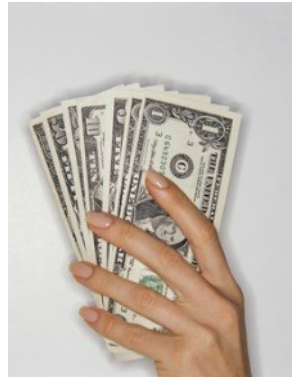
Follow up with a written thank you note!

Federal Student Aid FAFSA

Seniors can submit the FAFSA beginning October 1, 2017 for the 2018-19 school year. Although its length can be intimidating, it's a good idea to file the form as early as possible. Completing the FAFSA enables students to start the financial aid process and tap into the many federal and state resources that make college affordable. These resources include student grants, work-study, and loans.

Parents no longer need to worrying about completing the current year's taxes ASAP, as the FAFSA will use the 2016 tax return for the 2018-19 school year. Students need this tax information to answer many of the questions. At the same time, you'll learn the preliminary estimate of the amount your family is expected to contribute to your education. It is known as the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) and helps to determine any aid awards you might receive.
