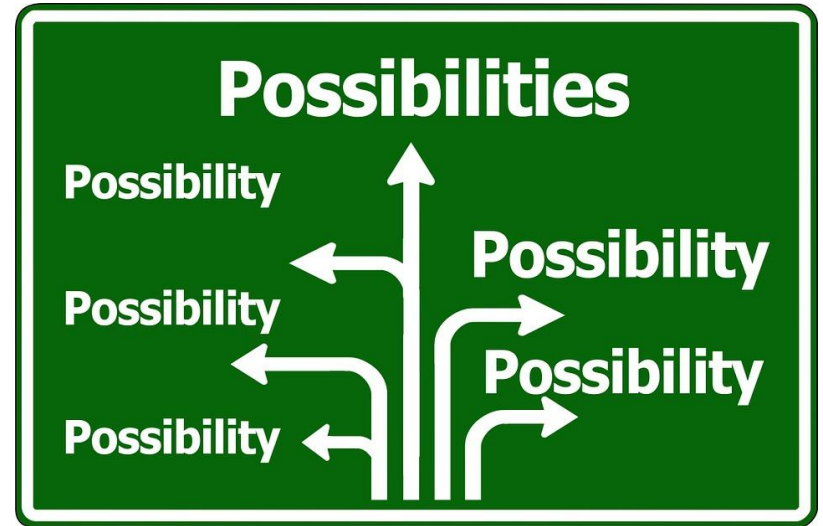

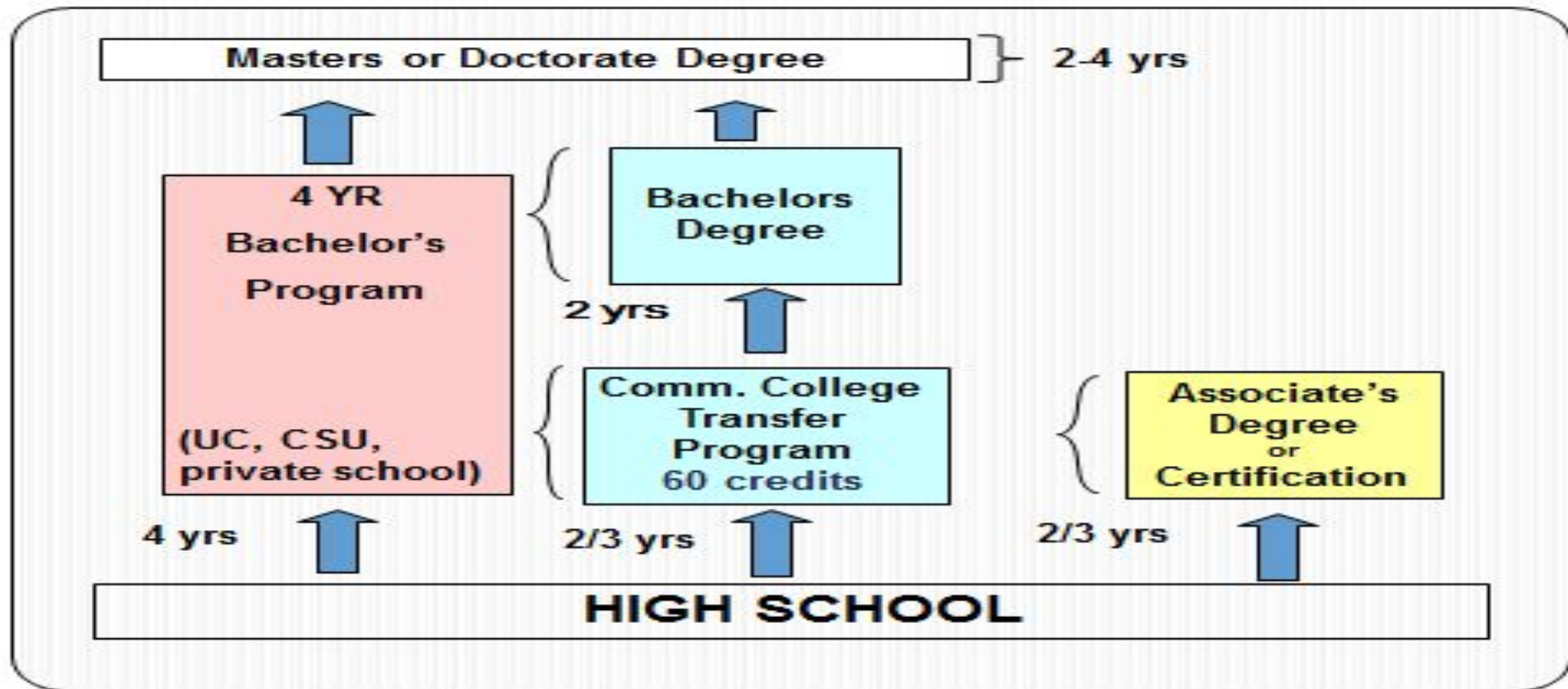

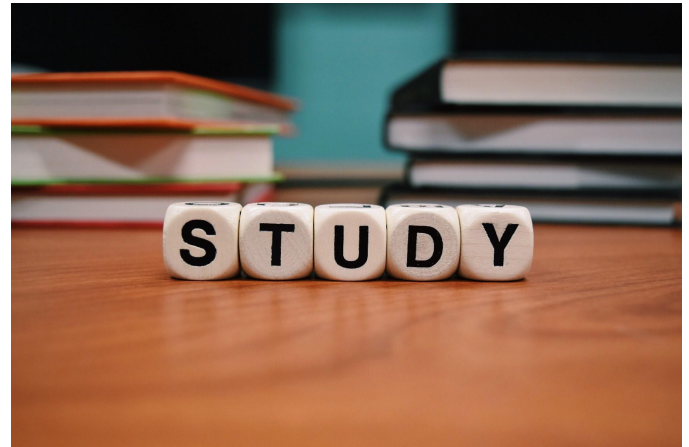

-  **SAT:** www.collegeboard.com **COST**
- May 8th Register by April 38th \$52.00
 - June 5th Register by May 6th \$68.00 with essay
-  **ACT:** www.act.org
- April 17th Register by March 12th \$55.00
 - June 12th Register by May 7th \$70.00 with writing

It is recommended to register as early as possible

Why is the PSAT Important?

PSAT is a practice test for the SAT that is normally offered in October. This year the College Board is offering another PSAT test administration in January. The January administration will have the same benefits as the October PSAT/NMSQT, including eligibility for programs administered by National Merit Scholarship Corporation. **More information to come.**

The PSAT/NMSQT serves as a **qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship Program**, which awards \$2,500 scholarships annually to high-scoring 11th graders.

Your results offer details on your performance in different areas and can help you determine which areas you need to improve and help guide you with your studying for the SAT

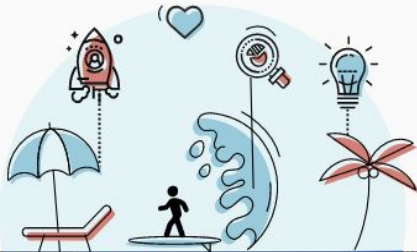
