## Online Distance Learning Program (Second Semester): New Student Registration Process

Dear El Dorado Union High School District Families,

The District remains committed to offering families educational options as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Families who do not want their students to attend school for in-person instruction during the spring semester may enroll in the District's Online Distance Learning Program. Schools in the District will continue to provide in-person instruction to the greatest extent possible following local and state guidelines.

The Online Distance Learning Program is most effective when students enroll at the start of the semester. Transferring during the semester creates challenges for students, and their options may be limited. All schools in the District are expected to return to full in-person instruction at some point. Therefore, it is recommended that families make an informed decision as to whether they want their student to participate in the Online Distance Learning Program prior to the start of Winter Break.
