



Why is the PSAT Important?

PSAT is a <u>practice test</u> for the SAT that is normally offered in October every year. We highly encourage juniors to take the PSAT.



The PSAT also serves as a **qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship Program**, which awards \$2, 500 scholarships annually to high-scoring 11th graders.

Your results offer details on your performance in different areas and can help you determine which areas you need to improve and help guide you with your studying for the SAT.


