

Fall 2024 Freshmen Eligibility

• Test FREE admissions

- High school graduate or equivalent
- Complete the 15-unit "a-g" college preparatory courses
- Earn qualifying "a-g" grade point average (GPA)
 - CA Residents: 2.5 or greater
 - Between 2.0 and 2.49 may be evaluated based on supplemental factors

Primary Factors


- GPA in all completed a-g courses (courses after 9th grade – 11th grade)
- GPA and courses taken in subjects relevant to selected major
- Number of academic courses beyond the minimum a-g requirements

Secondary Supplemental Factors

- Location of high school and educational opportunities available (free & reduced lunch, etc.)
- Student attributes: First generation, Low income, Foster youth, Military service
- Activities/Engagement outside of school: Extracurricular activities, Work/Volunteer experience, Leadership roles

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

Non-Impacted Campuses

Campuses accept all eligible applicants who meet minimum CSU admission requirements. Please note some campuses may have impacted programs.

Academic Preparation

Students are strongly encouraged to enroll in:

- English course for senior year
- Year-long mathematics or quantitative, scientific or data literacy course



Transfer Success Pathway Program

- Another pathway to the CSU through the community college
- Eligible: First-time freshman entering a community college
 - Not CSU eligible
 - Not able to attend due to financial or personal
- Guarantees a student future admission to a CSU in a specific program provided they meet requirements




