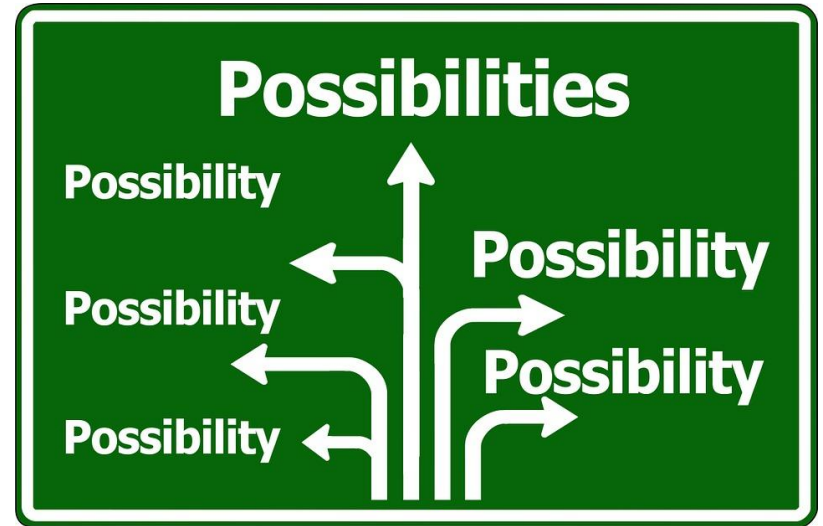

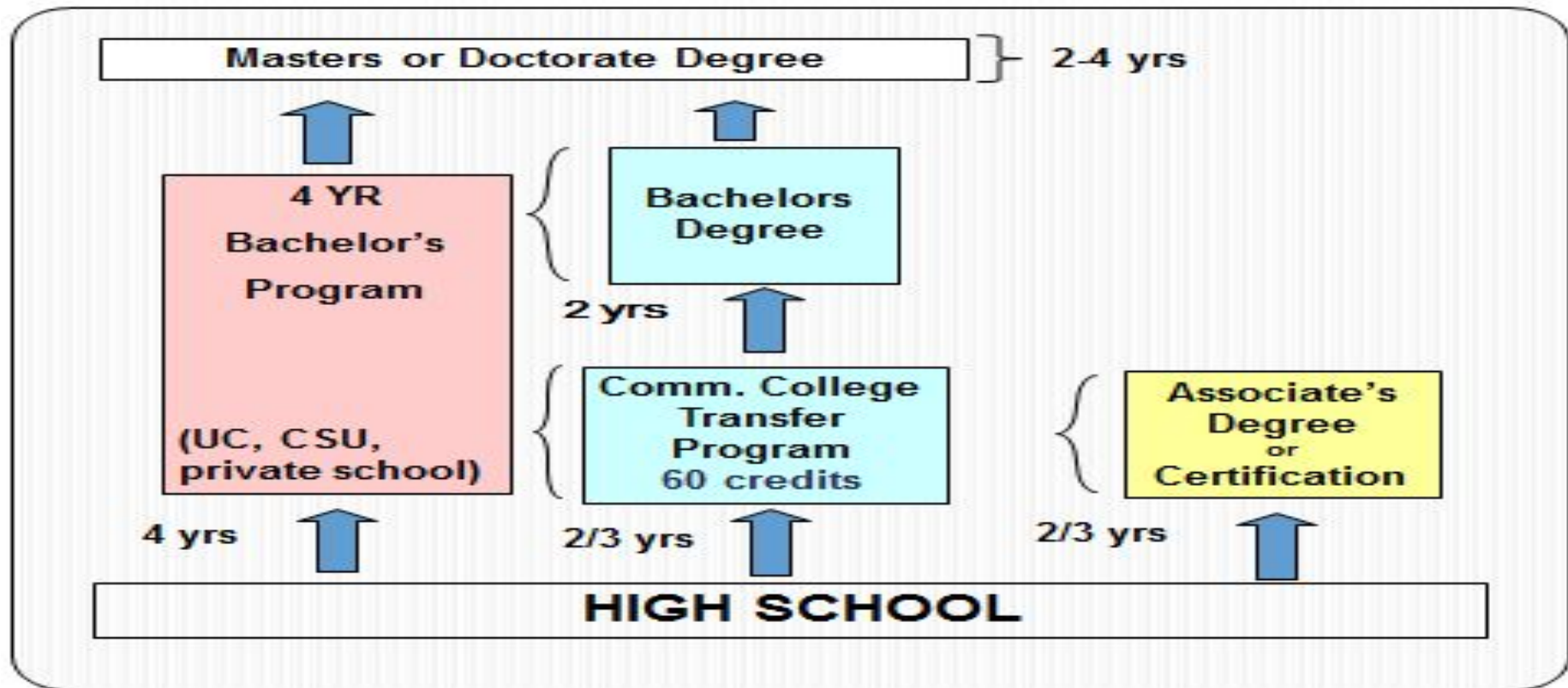

- A. Grades (A-G requirements)
- B. SAT/ACT scores (not required for UC campuses)
- C. Extra-Curricular Activities  
(not required for CSU campuses, except for SLO)

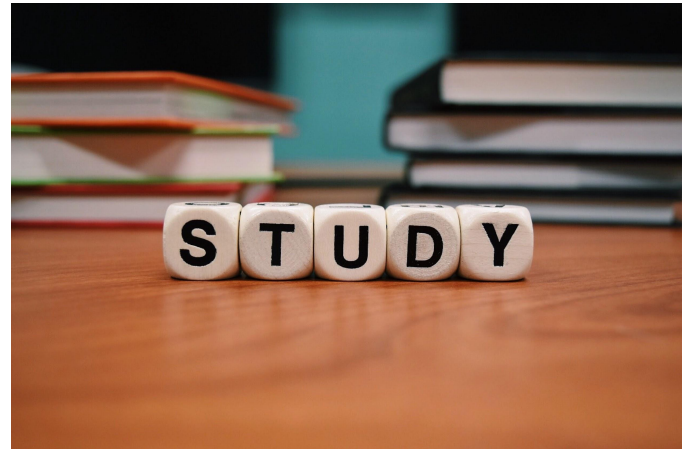

# Advanced Education at the Community College

**Get a head start on college by earning college credit while you are still in high school.**

**No Enrollment Fees!**

🍀 Qualified high school students are invited to take classes and earn college credit at any California Community College through the Advanced Education Program.

To participate, a student must:

- 🍀 Be at least 16 years old OR have already completed the 10th grade by the first day of the college class, and be currently enrolled in high school
- 🍀 Have a high school GPA of 2.7 or higher.\*

# Benefits of Advanced Education

- 🍷 Earn transferable college credits while in high school
- 🍷 Earn elective high school credits
  - 3 college credits = 10 high school credits
- 🍷 Opportunities to explore electives PHS doesn't offer
  - (Examples: Kinesiology, Business, Astronomy, Geology, Criminal Justice, Sign Language)
- 🍷 Take Career Technical Education classes
  - (Examples: Emergency Medical Technician, Early Childhood Education, Real Estate)

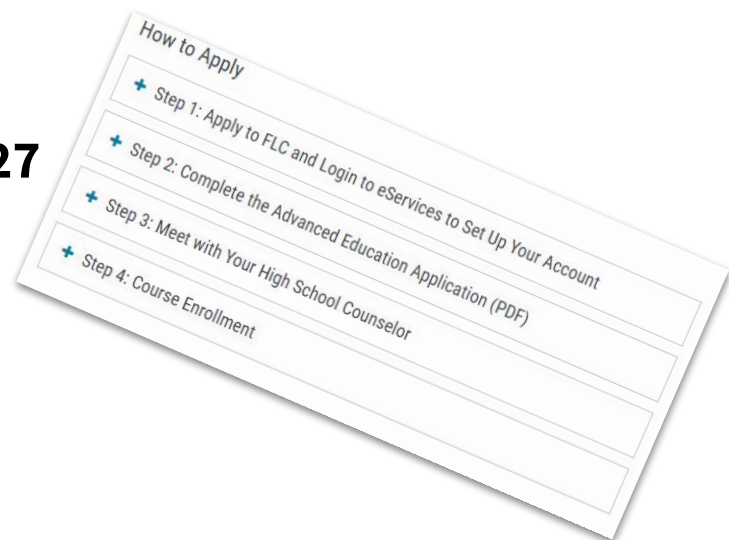
