





4 Year College Option





Out of State Colleges

- Check school's website for application information and deadlines
- Out-of-state tuition (usually more \$\$\$)
- Residency requirements vary
- Admission requirements and deadlines vary check with each school
- WUE (Western Undergraduate Exchange) www.wiche.edu
 - Tuition Reduction!

- 1. Complete a FAFSA application
 - a. FAFSA has made changes!
 - Reduced number of questions automatic transfer of data from IRS, aid eligibility formulas
 - b. Due to new California State Assembly Bill (AB 469), <u>every senior</u> is required to complete a FAFSA application or complete a waiver
- 2. Complete the CSS Profile (only if your college requires it)



Do I send a transcript with my college application?

- UC / CSU send transcripts <u>at the end</u> of Senior year <u>unless otherwise</u> communicated by the college/university.
- Common Application Counselor will upload via Secondary School Report
- Coalition Application Counselor will upload via Secondary School Report
- Out of State or other universities not using Common App or Coalition check with each school on transcript process.
- Community College send transcripts at the end of Senior year

Careers without Bachelor's Degree

Examples of high-paying careers that only require an Associate Degree or CTE training

• Radiation Therapist

- Median pay: \$80,160
- Job growth through 2024: 14%

• Diagnostic Medical Sonographer

- Median pay: \$69,650
- Job growth through 2024: 26.4%

Occupational Therapy Assistant

- Median pay: \$59,010
- Job growth through 2024: 42.7%

Dental Hygienist

- Median pay: \$72,910
- Job growth through 2024: 18.6%

• Geological and Petroleum Technician

- Median pay: \$56,470
- Job growth through 2024: 11.8%





A trade school or career college

sometimes referred to as a vocational school, technical school, or vocational college, is a post-secondary institution that's designed to give students the technical skills to prepare them for a specific occupation.



Apprenticeships

Training in the trades (plumber, electricians, carpenters, etc) provides SKILLED hands-on experience leading to full-time jobs.




