WHY ENROLL IN ADVANCED EDUCATION?

- Get a head start on your **college education**
- Gain **college knowledge**
- Classes are **tuition FREE**, you only provide books and materials for classes
- MOST classes **transfer** to CSU, UC, private and out of state colleges
- Advanced education students may enroll in **one** or **two college courses** each semester across the Los Rios District (American River, Cosumnes River, Folsom Lake, and Sacramento City College)

WHO IS ELIGIBLE...?

- Students age **16 years old** or have completed **10th** grade *
- Class must be approved by your high school counselor
- You demonstrate you are a successful student as shown through transcripts, letters of support from high school counselors and teachers, and/or other academic success indicators



***Exceptions for age requirement may be made for students that can succeed in college level coursework, student can go through an appeals process.**

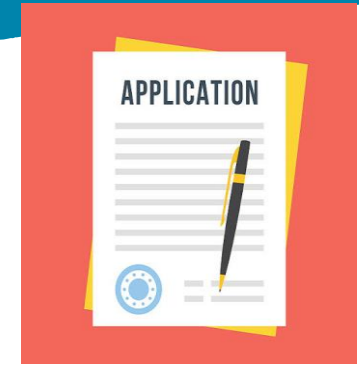

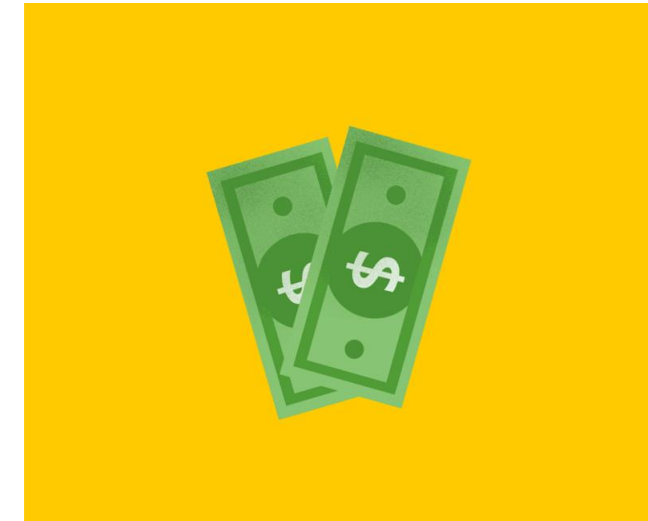
