
DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM

WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

Dual Enrollment is a program that allows current high school students to take classes at Folsom Lake College.

Dual Enrollment students may enroll in 11 units each semester (across the Los Rios district). Applications must be submitted to each individual college.

- MOST classes transfer to CSU, UC, private and out of state colleges





WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR DUAL ENROLLMENT?


- The student has started the 9th grade or will be at least 14 years old by the first day of instruction
- The course the student wants to take is not available at their high school (applies to the summer term only).
- The student is prepared for dual enrollment as recommended by the high school principal or their designee.
- If you are a high school student, then you need parental consent to be enrolled at the college.


CCAP and Non-CCAP

CCAP

- Classes during the school day at your high school
- Restricted enrollment to your high school district
- \$0 cost to students (no fees, no textbook costs)
- Support & Guidance with enrollment process

Non-CCAP

- Before or after school typically offered at a Folsom Lake College Campus
- · Open enrollment to the public
- Student is responsible for Universal Transit Pass (UTP) fee, textbook & material costs
- Self-guided enrollment process

STEPS TO APPLY


- STEP ONE: <u>APPLY TO FLC</u> (AS A HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT)
- STEP TWO: FILL OUT THE SPECIAL ADMIT FORM UPLOAD THROUGH ONLINE SUBMISSION PROCESS
- STEP THREE: IF YOU QUALIFY, FLC Admissions will register you IN THE CLASSES YOU HAVE SELECTED BEGINNING DEC. 14TH
- STUDENTS CANNOT REGISTER FOR CLASSES, OUR ADMISSIONS OFFICE MUST DO IT FOR STUDENTS
- ONLY SUBMIT FLC SPECIFIC CLASSES ON THE FLC DUAL ENROLLMENT APPLICATION, DO NOT INCLUDE CLASSES FROM ARC, CRC, OR SCC APPLY FOR THOSE SEPARATELY



Once you establish a password in eServices you will use this to log into your Los Rios Gmail


Go to Student Login (Top right corner of FLC webpage) and click Los Rios Gmail

- Transfer students must have a cumulative 2.0 grade point average.
- Transfer credit may not be reflected on transcript.


