WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

Dual Enrollment is a program that allows current high school students to take classes at Folsom Lake College.

Dual Enrollment students may enroll in 11 units each semester (across the Los Rios district). Applications must be submitted to each individual college.



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WHY ENROLL IN DUAL ENROLLMENT?

- Get a head start on your **college education**
- Gain **college knowledge**
- Classes are **tuition FREE**, you only provide books and materials for classes
- MOST classes **transfer** to CSU, UC, private and out of state colleges



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WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR DUAL ENROLLMENT?

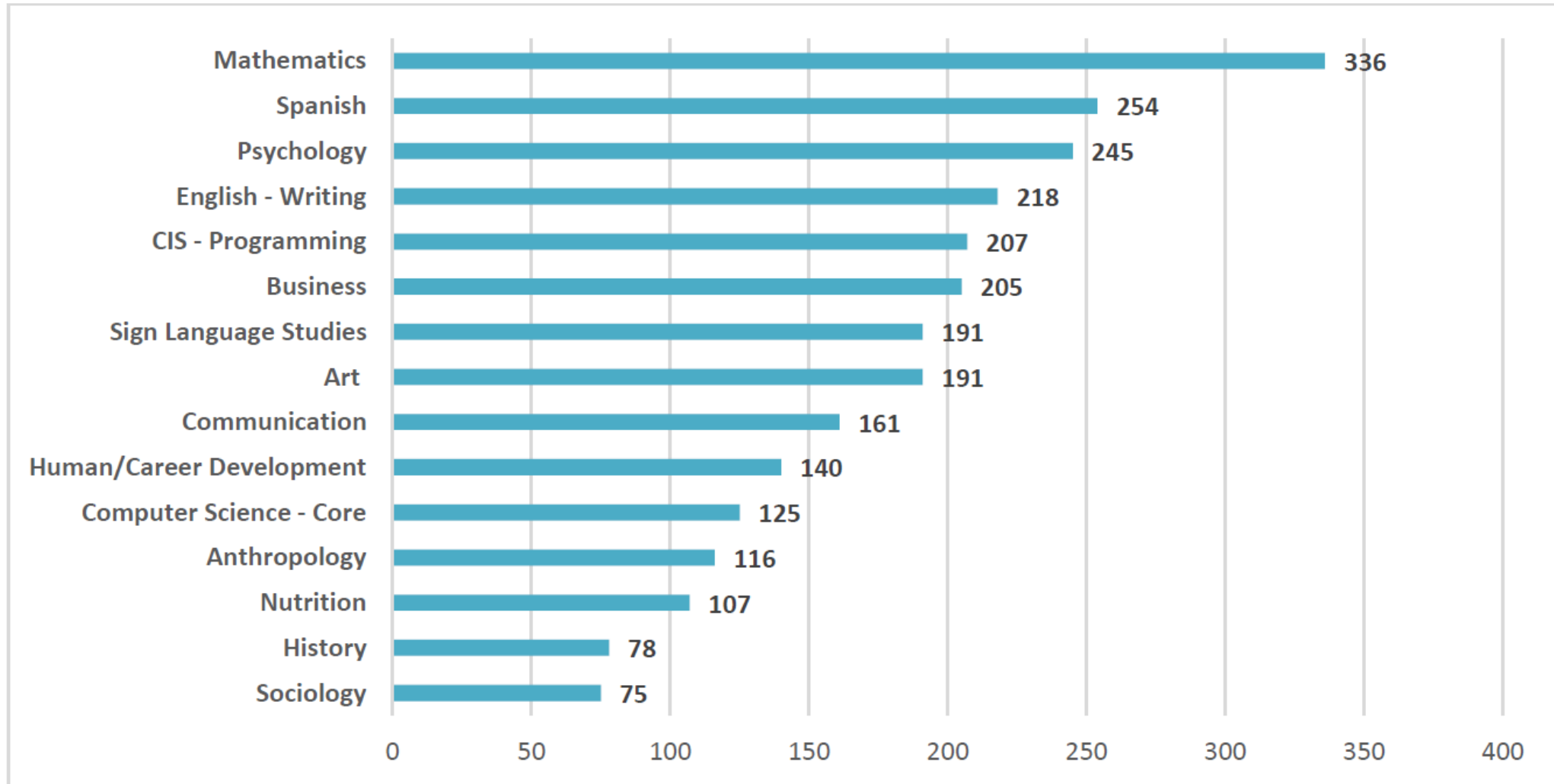
- The student has started the 9th grade or will be at least 14 years old by the first day of instruction
- The course the student wants to take is not available at their high school (applies to the summer term only).
- The student is prepared for dual enrollment as recommended by the high school principal or their designee.
- If you are a high school student, then you need parental consent to be enrolled at the college.

- Open enrollment to the public
- Student is responsible for Universal Transit Pass (UTP) fee, textbook & material costs

- Transfer students must have a cumulative 2.0 grade point average.
- Transfer credit may not be reflected on transcript.

A grade point average (GPA) is computed for each student at the end of each semester/term. The semester/term GPA is determined by dividing the total number of grade points earned during the semester/term by the number of semester units attempted. Only courses for which grades of A, B, C, D, and F earned are counted as units attempted.

Counseling, support services, and academic accommodations are provided to students who are eligible for the program

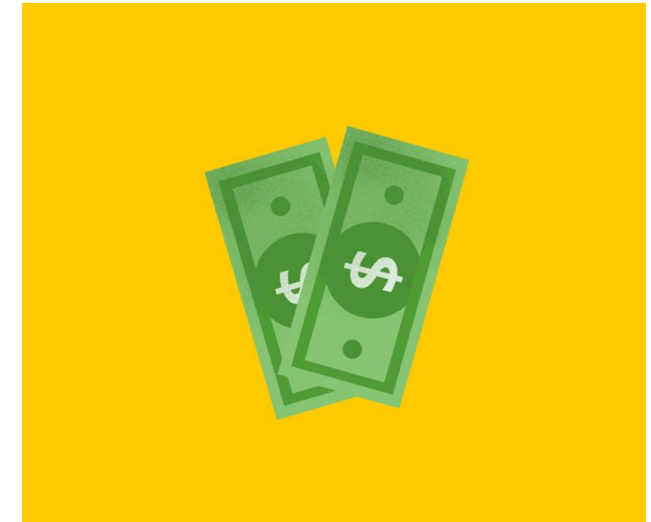
