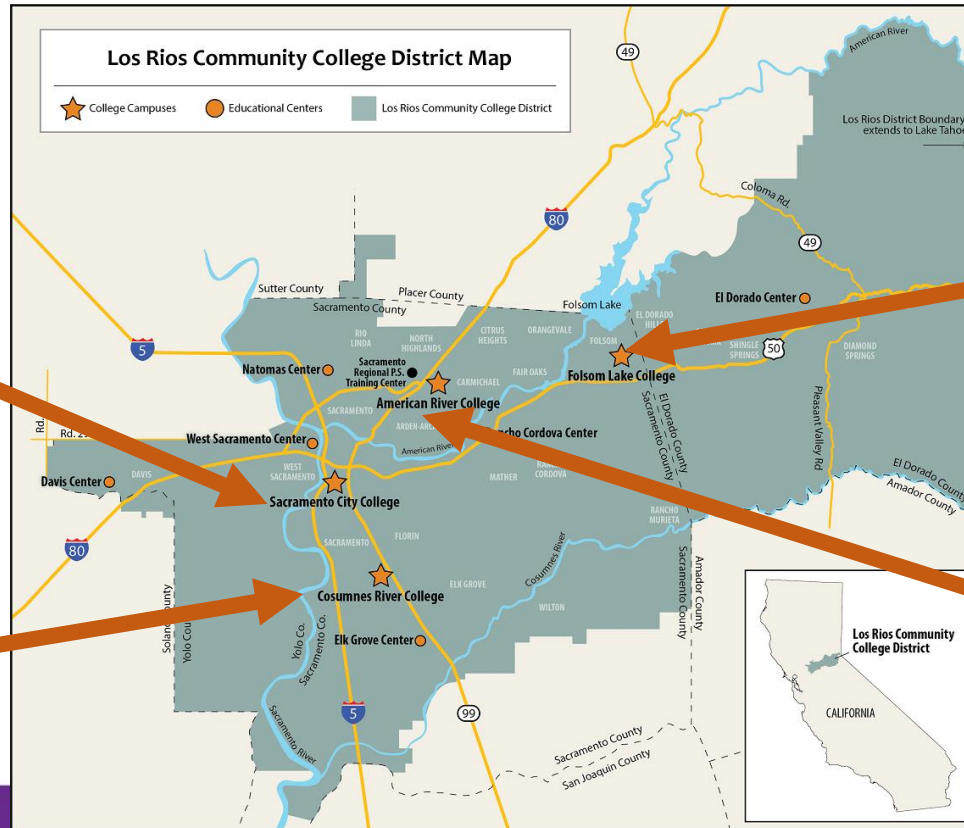

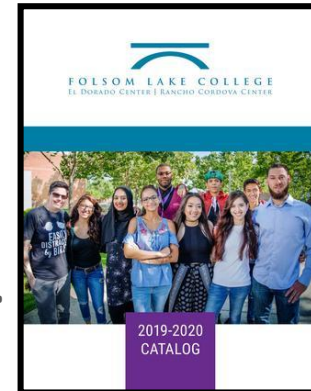

PREPARING FOR COLLEGE

- Complete your A-G requirements – our classes are just as rigorous as the UC and CSU.
 - Take Advanced Education classes at FLC or use AP classes to receive college credit.
1. Think about your interests and research which colleges offer the programs you want to study.
 2. Review the classes offered in a specific program – see which classes you can take that make up a specific degree or certificate.
 3. Make a plan to engage with the college prior to high school graduation – **TALK WITH YOUR HS COUNSELOR** about the opportunities.



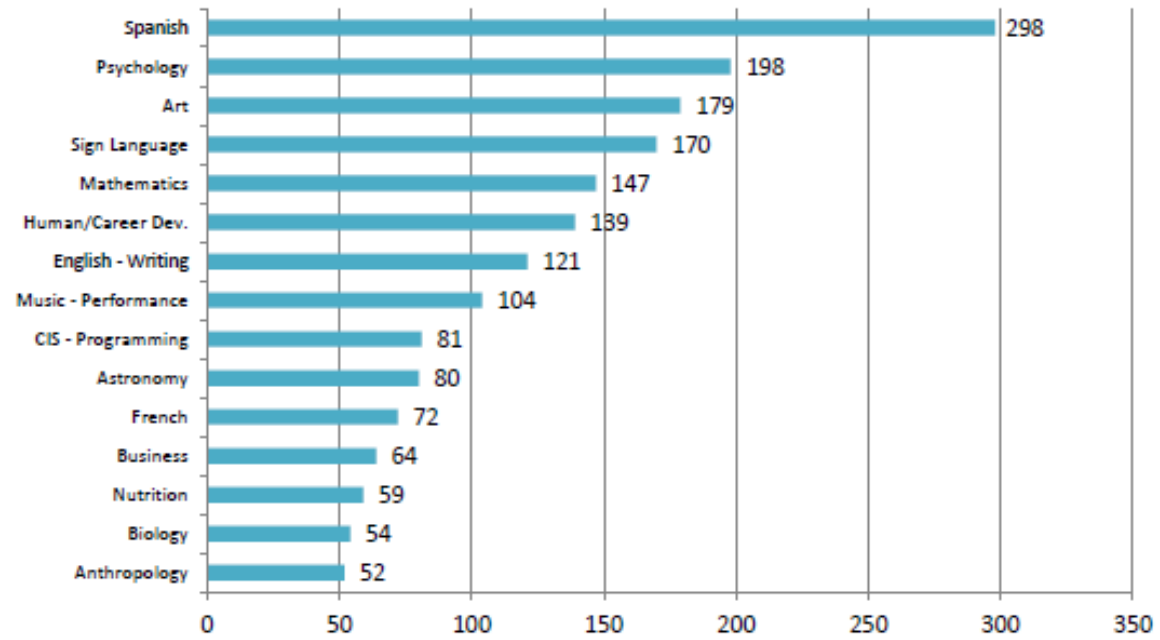
LOS RIOS ADVANCED EDUCATION

Advanced Education is a program for current high school students who enroll at Folsom Lake College while earning both high school and college credit. The depth of knowledge you will gain from this experience is invaluable!

- **Students can take 2 classes each semester (Fall, Spring, & Summer)**
- **Must be 16 OR complete Soph. year – 2.7 GPA or above**
- **MOST classes transfer to CSU, UC, private and out of state colleges**
- **Classes are TUITION FREE (small registration fees still apply)***
- **Receive high school and college credit**

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR COURSES

1. APPLY ONLINE TO FLC: Receive your Los Rios ID#
2. COMPLETE THE ADVANCED EDUCATION PACKET (available on the FLC website)
 - Email the completed application to your high school counselor for their signature.
 - Counselor submits application via email to FLC Admissions and Records.
3. EMAIL COMMUNICATION FROM A&R: Approved/Not Approved – 5 business days or less
4. IF APPROVED: Admissions and Records will enroll you in the class.
5. PAY FEES: Tuition fees are waived for Advanced Education students however there may a supplies fee.



FEES AND PAYMENTS

In eServices (Financial Account) you can see how much your registration fees are. You can also pay online using a debit or credit card.

- Tuition is waived = 0 cost
- \$2.25 per unit
- \$1.00 student rep fee per campus (ARC, FLC, CRC, or SCC)
- Universal Transit Pass fee – access to transportation
