Freshman Admission – COVID-19 policy

ON MARCH 31, THE UC REGENTS APPROVED:

 A temporary suspension of the letter grade requirement for A-G courses completed in winter, spring and summer 2020.





Freshman Admission – COVID-19 policy explained

PASS (P) or CREDIT (CR) GRADES in A-G REQUIREMENTS

- UC will accept P (CR) grades in A-G courses completed in winter, spring, and summer 2020 to meet A-G requirements.
- UC will NOT accept letter grades of D or F to meet A-G requirements.

Freshman Admission – Standardized tests

CHANGES in STANDARDIZED TEST REQUIREMENT

- Immediately: SAT Essay/ACT Writing requirement eliminated
- Until fall 2024: ACT/SAT requirement
 suspended for all California freshmen





Freshman Admission – Standardized test timeline

Campus consideration of test scores

- Fall 2021 and 2022:
 - Submitting scores is optional for students
 - Campuses may consider scores as part of Comprehensive Review
- Fall 2023 and 2024:

- Campuses cannot consider scores in selection for students attending California high schools
- Fall 2025 and beyond: new test or elimination of standardized test requirement

- Guarantee to a *specific major* at 1 of 6 campuses offering TAG agreements
- Hundreds of major options available!





Transfer Admission – temporary modifications due to COVID-19

ON MARCH 31, THE UC REGENTS APPROVED:

 A temporary suspension of the cap on P/NP (CR/NC) units for winter, spring and summer 2020 coursework.





Transfer Admission – temporary modifications due to COVID-19

P/NP (CR/NC) GRADES IN MAJOR PREP

- All campuses will accept P (CR) grades for admission purposes in major prep courses completed in spring 2020 for all majors.
 - Exception: Psychology and Cognitive Science majors at UC Santa Cruz require letter grades in major preparatory coursework.


Tuition and Financial Aid

Cost to own over 5 years <u>vs.</u> Student loan payments & Interest	\$26,863	\$13,080
Total Cost at 5 years	\$48,733	\$13,080
Value After 5 Years <u>vs.</u> Avg. earnings over 5 years	\$12,815	\$202,580


